

## How to build your scrapbook

- Adhesive – anything like a glue stick or double sided sticky tape is perfect. If you have some Washi tape already at home then this will also add a nice touch
- Pens and felt tips – you will use these to write out titles, comments, labels and much more
- Resources – this of course is the most important part of the scrapbook, you will need some interesting content to include in your scrapbook.

### Content
